I taught at Beverly Hills Highschool, Irvine Highschool, El Rancho Highschool, and several others around Los Angeles and Orange County in southern California. My students have went onto prestigious music schools including USC and UCLA. I've taught for Recreational Music Center in San Diego as the lead drum instructor and curriculum developer, as well as was Director of Bands. I was also HEAD counselor for GRAMMY camp, an international camp for musicians 14 - 18 looking for a career in the music industry, sponsored by the GRAMMY'S.

✓ **PLAY YOUR FAVORITE SONGS**

Learn how to play your favourite songs from your favourite bands. This is a great way to light the fire of passion for music. I believe strongly that this is the best way to learn music, hear music, and keep the passion going.

Learning how to read music is fundamental to being a good musician. It's like learning a new language. You won't perfect the language if you don't learn it. It also allows you to learn more in your own time and exponentially improve your abilities while learning the vocabulary for music.

If you want to be a great drummer, you need to know how to play with good time keeping skills. Through training with me you will learn all about the metronome and will regularly practice with different tempos and time signatures.



✓ **HOW TO PLAY WITH GOOD TECHNIQUE**

Good technique is crucial to being a good musician. Your abilities to play are only limited by your capacity to understand and exhibit good playing technique. It is also used for safety reasons as playing drums is very physical and playing wrong can lead to tendonitis and other physical ailments.

No contracts

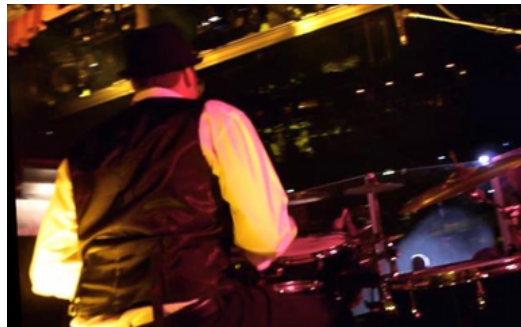
I don't require any contracts for my services; simple handshake agreements will do. All I ask in return is good faith agreements around my services. I love what I do and I am a very passionate teacher that simply wants to help others reach new levels of success with their musical journey.

Lesson commitments

Getting better and staying motivated with anything only happens with commitment. On top of that, this is an income for me, therefore **I require weekly drum lesson commitments** around my services. This typically means 4 lessons a month.

Lesson cancellations

Life has its complications, and from time to time, students need to cancel. This is not a problem. If a student cancels, **I will offer a make-up date and time or double the time of the next lesson.** For example, if your lesson is 30 minutes, I will make the next lesson one hour. If I need to cancel for any reason, the same principle applies.



Payments

Like most service based businesses I do **require monthly installments** for lessons, meaning a package of 4 lessons will be due up front. Your monthly payments will be due from the date of your first lesson. If your lessons start on the 15th of the month, they will be due every 15th of every month.
